
The speaker gives a detailed overview about the provisions pertaining to Acid Attack. He made students aware about this heinous

#### **DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE COURSE**

### 15th September, 2022: Opening Ceremony and First Session

NEP, 2020 Taskforce Committee, Swami Shraddhananda College, University of Delhi in collaboration with Delhi State Legal Services Authority started an Online Add-On Course on "Legal Awareness" for its students from 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 to 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2022. The main objective behind this course was to spread legal literacy/awareness about the important laws/products and DSLSA/DLSA among the young generation. To assess students' understanding with topics, the MCQ questionnaire was prepared and the same Google link was shared with students after the related session.

Afterwards, Prof. Balaram Pani, Dean of Colleges delivered his address and highlighted thatit is imperative for every individual in the society to be aware about their, legal rights and duties to seek help from Indian judiciary in case of denial of their any legal right.

Thereafter, Sh. Shrihari Borikar, Zonal Organizing Secretary. Akhil Bhartiya Adhivakta Parishad delivered his address and throws light on the significance of spreading legal awareness among young generation. He also stressed on some areas where development is required in Indian Judiciary System to make it more effective.

Shri Bharat Parashar, Member Secretary, DSLSA expressed gratitude to all who participated and appreciated the initiative of Swami Shraddhanand College in spreading legal awareness among the young generation. Afterwards, Mr. Sushant Changotra, Special Secretary, DSLSA took the stage and educated the participants about the importance of legal literacy in one's life and how this knowledge can change their lives. ## ICC Report 2020-2022










### "Awareness Talk on Gender Sensitization-The POSH Act"




