Apart from these initiatives, the students with visual disability have been provided laptops equipped with essential software, which would help them to read and store E-books and prepare notes. The college library in association with the Enabling Unit, has also provided them the digital audio recorders (Angels) in order to facilitate them for recording of lectures in

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the class room. The convener Sh. Manish Kumar Sharma, members Sh. Bijay Kumar Padhan and Sh. Pankaj Lakhera are actively involved for the betterment of differently-abled students and teachers in the college. The Enabling Unit is in the process of getting mathematic kits to the visually challenged students from the office of Equal Opportunity Cell, University of Delhi.

Examination Branch

Examination In-charge Sh. R.K. Srivastava, Associate Professor in the department of Mathematics did a commendable job in streamlining the process of examination reforms in the college. This includes conducting the class test Examination, strengthening Internal Evaluation process and setting up the master time-table for the smooth functioning of the academic schedule of the college.
