A meeting of the IPR cell was held on 10/01/2024. The IPR cell proposed to conduct following activities:-


- i) The IPR cell will guide student and faculty in the college for protecting their intellectual properties and to create awareness and to facilitate the filing of patent applications.









### Minutes of the Meeting

A meeting of the IPR cell was held on 31/05/2023 and following objectives were discussed.


- i) the legal rights provided to the inventor to protect his/her invention in order to reap commercial benefits.
